 ●*Lost Abbey Red Poppy Wild Ale (CA). *Muddy caramel, tan head. Medium body, sour, lots of oak astringency, with good balance and finish. Flavors of sour cherries, rotting apples, cedar, caramel, chocolate, old sweater, cinnamon, and more barnyard funk.* 5.0% {97% 4.0 4.3}.....27.50/375ml
 Dogfish/Victory/Stone Saison Du Buff (DE). *Brewed with parsley, sage, rosemary & thyme - hazy gold, white head. Medium body, malty and creamy, bitter, finish. Flavors of banana, orange peel, resin, dry hops, and subtle herb.* 6.8%.....7.75
 ●*Avery/Russian River Litigation Belgian Ale (CO). *Cloudy orange-brown, tan head. Full body, creamy, sweet and malty, with big flavors of banana, orange, plum, caramel, coriander, and clove.* 8.9%17.00/22oz
 Dark Horse Double Crooked Tree Double IPA (MI). *Cloudy copper-amber, off-white head. Medium body, big alcohol well balanced by big sharp hops and caramel malts. Flavors of fresh pine, pineapple, orange, and caramel.* 13.6%.....10.00
 Lagunitas Imperial Red Ale (CA). *Deep red amber, off-white head. Medium body, big, sweet, malts, with flavors of burnt sugar, molasses, toffee, pine, and grapefruit.* 7.5%.....5.75
 Flying Dog Kujo Coffee Stout (MD). *Black, brown head. Medium body, acidic with lively carbonation, bitter finish. Flavors of dark roast coffee with notes of caramel and grass.* 8.9%.....7.00
 Bell's Third Coast Old Ale (MI). *Brown with tan head. Medium to full body, sweet and malty, great balance, with satisfying bitter finish. Rich flavors of nuts, toffee and brown sugar.* 10.2%7.50

 Great Divide Hibernation Old Ale (CO). *Red-amber, beige head. Medium to full body, sweet and malty, lightly chewy, with good hop balance on the long finish. Flavor of raisins, dates, smoke, oak, brown sugar, and tobacco.* 8.7%.....5.75
 ●*Unibroue Quelque Chose Cherry Ale (CN). *Red-orange, with bright flavors of cherry and notes of sage, apple, vanilla and cloves.* 8.0%20.00/750
 Two Brothers Northwind Imperial Stout (IL). *Black, brown head. Medium body, dry, with lightly bitter finish. Flavors of dark roast coffee and bittersweet chocolate.* 8.5%.....5.75
 Victory Yakima Glory Dark IPA (PA). *Dark amber with tan head. Medium body, chewy and somewhat sweet, good balance of robust malts and some sharp hops, with flavors of cut pine, resin, grapefruit, passion fruit, roses, toast, and caramel.* 8.7%6.75
 ●*Victory Dark Intrigue Imperial Stout (PA). *Oak-aged Storm King - Black, brown head. Full body, chewy, lively carbonation, dry, bitter, finish. Mellow flavors of bourbon, roast coffee, roast barley, cocoa, grass, grapefruit, and oak* 9.1%.....22.00/750
